MOVING FORWARD



Great News!

Year One of our state-wide trails video passed its final edits. Lori Elliott, Grant Administrator, has sent the web-site link to all our sponsors and clubs who participated. You will find the link in the Keystone Snowmobiler, Pennsylvania State Snowmobile Association (PSSA) web-site and Facebook. Please use it to spread the work of all our clubs, sponsors, PSSA, American Council of Snowmobile Associations (ACSA) and the International Snowmobile Association (ISMA). Without their help both financially and in the generous giving of their time this would not have been possible. Thank you to Mike Grant, Executive Producer for "Snow Trails TV" who went out of his way to make this video.

The video will be shown on the Destination America Channel at 8am the first two Sundays in October. **It is worth your time to view.**

Year Two planning of the "Snow Trails" video project is almost complete.

Year Two will feature the Poconos and Huntingdon County plus Erie County and the PA Wild's. We are in need of sponsors from the PA Wilds – Benezette/Clearfield/ St. Mary's area. One may have the good fortune to see an Elk during a snowmobile ride in these areas! Any business, tourism bureau or person can help sponsor an area. **This is a great opportunity for your trails to be given national attention thru this TV show.** The "Snow Trails" TV program is currently changing to Sunday morning at 8am. What can you do to help improve our snowmobile trails? Support your local clubs and PSSA for starters. Contact your local representatives and urge them to support land owners (HB 544). Explain the need for an increase in the Registration

Fee. Since the current fee of \$10 has been the rate for many years most members recognize the situation as in need of an increase. If we want the trails to continue we will need to embrace a sizeable increase in the next year or two. **You should plan ahead for an increase. Is the glass half-full or half empty?** I think it is important to keep a perspective on this fee. What does \$25 - \$50 buy today? (Haircut, good dinner, case of beer, nice blouse/shirt, DVR) What did the sled cost that you are riding? The clothing and equipment that you purchased?

It is important to note that NOTHING has been finalized and discussions will continue with DCNR. As of this writing I am waiting for more information. **We need facts before we can discuss anything.**

Plan to attend the Annual PowerSport Show October 27 -5pm – October 29 – 3:30 pm

Features include: Friday night (weather permitting) the "**Tough Trucks**". The **Tractor Pulls** will return for the Saturday event. An **Antique Car Show** is being planned for the Sunday event. This show has something for everyone. The Show will have our vendors, used sled corral, auction, used clothing booth, ticket sales and PSSA clothing as always. The trailer and ATV drawing will be held on Sunday at 3:30 pm. **Volunteers are needed.** If you can help in any way contact Travis Mathna the PowerSport Chair at (1-717-677-8089).

Plan to be there. Help support your Association!

Tickets for chances on the two trailers donated by Blizzard and an ATV donated by the dealers should be returned promptly. Please be generous. All proceeds are used to support PSSA programs.

Meanwhile, we have sleds which are not registered or carry insurance. Clubs need to work with the local State Police and establish a Safety Check Program for their area. **The Snowmobile Fund needs every sled to be registered.** Clubs need to insist on this at their events. Why increase the fee if we are not going to have law enforcement on our trails? **It is up to each one of us to promote trails in Pennsylvania.**

Clubs who conduct small games of chance raffles are reminded that the State requires a license and permit for your events. If you have any questions contact your county Treasurer.

NEWS FROM PSSA'S GRANTS ADMINISTRATOR



Hello, Pennsylvania Snowmobilers!

Now is an opportune time to learn more about the Pennsylvania State Snowmobile Association (PSSA) by viewing our brand new video program, "Snowmobiling in Pennsylvania", developed with executive producer, Mike Grant, of the "Snow Trails TV" program. You may have seen this program about other states on the Destination America channel, but this is the first time Pennsylvania will be featured! As Liz Krug mentioned, the actual TV program will be shown on October 1st and 8th at 8:00 a.m. on the Destination America Channel.

Thanks to the support of PSSA, the International Snowmobile Manufacturers Association, the ANF Visitors Bureau, the PA Great Outdoors Visitors Bureau, and the Somerset County Tourism Grant Program for their financial support. Many thanks also to PSSA member clubs who served as trail guides. You can view this 20-minute video through the PSSA website at <http://www.pasnow.org/snow-trail-tv/> and learn what PSSA does for you, in addition to what the counties of Cameron, Forest, McKean and Somerset Counties have to offer: snowmobile clubs, snowmobile trails and amenities.

Each year PSSA applies for grant funds and sponsorships to promote the sport across the state and to re-grant mini-grants to PA snowmobile clubs to help with trail expenses. Your membership fees and donations help PSSA continue this work to support snowmobiling in Pennsylvania. Here are a sampling of grant funds received since 2006:

Mini-Grant Trail Projects – Total funds awarded: \$541,600. Since 2006, these funds have funded to date 130 projects carried out by 25 clubs across the state. These mini-grants are used for fuel, to repair equipment, and to repair, maintain, and groom snowmobile trails for all riders to enjoy. Club volunteers have logged close to 18,197 hours maintaining or grooming trails at a value of approximately \$428,800. PSSA is currently reviewing 14 more mini-grant applications for fall trail maintenance and construction projects

and grooming for the 2017-18 snowmobiling season. We hope to announce those awards in October.

Navigational Signage and GPS – Total: \$73,500 for three phases. PSSA's goal with this project is to obtain consistent trail signage system across the state by improving the trail-marking system in the state and bringing Pennsylvania in line with best practices of snow-belt states, while also addressing problems of navigation and safety that plague both local and visiting snowmobile riders. Club volunteers GPS the trails and post intersection signs with the county initials and the intersection number that corresponds to the number on the map. You may have seen these orange diamond signs on the trails. Former PSSA Board Member, Glen Knisely, was instrumental in coordinating the volunteers and field work involved with this project.

Marketing Grant from PA Department of Community and Economic Development – \$50,000. PSSA purchased four web cameras to post in four key snowmobiling areas of the state. These web cameras provide live streaming of trail conditions directly to the PSSA website. This grant also paid for services to create the "Pennsylvania Snowmobiling" Facebook page which has over 10,000 likes!

VisitErie Cooperative Marketing Grant – \$8,000. PSSA partnered with Presque Isle Downs and Casino and Baymont Inn and Suites in Erie for a snowmobiling package and created a TV spot promoting PSSA, snowmobile clubs, and attracting snowmobilers to the Erie area.

International Snowmobile Manufacturers Association – Several grants totaling over \$20,000 enabled us to hold events, perform an economic impact study, and produce our recent video program.

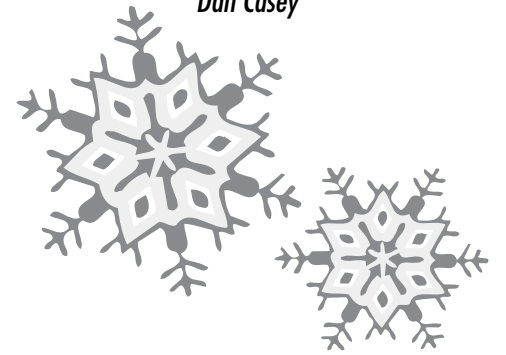
If anyone out there rides and is interested in belonging to a snowmobile club, we have some memberships available. You can visit

Another year has gone by and we are getting ready for the annual PSSA Powersports Show, again this year at the Lebanon Expo Center.

If you are not familiar with how you can sell your equipment at the Powersports Show, here is a quick explanation: Bring your equipment and walk to the Used Sled Corral table. Fill out a 3-part carbon-less form for each item. You can save time by printing a sample form from the website (www.papowersports.com) and filling in all the info before coming to the show. Then transfer the info to the 3-part form. Pay the fee for each unit. Our friendly volunteers will then unload sleds and move trailers into the building. We do the rest!

On the form you will list the selling price and indicate if you are firm or negotiable on that price. You will list a 'bottom line' price if you choose negotiable. Our volunteers will not reveal the 'bottom line' to a potential buyer, but will attempt to get the highest price for you. If we sell your unit, we collect the money and hold it for you. Machines or money must be claimed no later than 5 pm on Sunday, an hour after the show closes.

Those machines that are not sold during the show are often sold later, as a result of someone seeing it at the show. They tell another person in the days following the show, that person calls for info, and the deal is made!

For current PSSA members, the fee for each unit (sled, trailer, motorcycle, or ATV) placed in the Corral will be \$25.00. Pay the fee when you arrive with your machine.

For the non-members, we will not require that they join PSSA, but the fee for them will be \$60.00 per unit. If they wish to join, they will save ten bucks by doing so, as the consignment fee will be \$25., and the membership is \$25., for a total of only \$50.00.

For those persons buying a unit, PSSA members can make a purchase with no extra charge, non-members will be charged a fee of \$35.00.

We expect most non-members to recognize the value of PSSA membership and make a decision to join (so they can save the extra ten bucks!). If a person does not wish to join, PSSA gets the additional ten dollars!

One very important feature of the Used Sled Corral is the great group of volunteers that make it happen. Over the years we have learned to know a number of fine folks who help at the Corral, some help a few hours and others help many hours. Each and every one is appreciated; we can't do it without you. 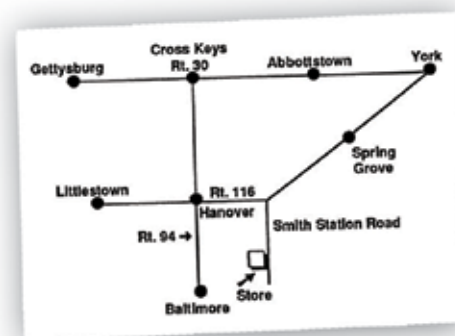

THE MARIENVILLE TRAIL RIDERS SMC JOINS FORCES

The Marienville Trail Riders Snowmobile Club are joining forces with the Forest County ATV Club and the Equestrian Riders from the Marienville area to help clear the former Knox/Kane Railroad. The club was asked by the Jenks Township supervisors to help clear the large brush away from the grade to help the township in getting the trail ready for this winter. This new trail is part of the Marienville All Season Trail that was recently acquired from Headwaters. It will be used to provide walking, biking, and equestrian usage. The two mile section north of Marienville will also be used in the wintertime for snowmobiling. This new trail will connect, two miles north of Marienville to Trail 12, which is a connecting trail to The Allegheny National Forest Trail 1 near Kelly Pines. If you go West at that intersection of the new trail and Trail 12, you can go to Kellettsville or Mayburg. In either direction you will be able to connect with the ANF Trail 1. fall picnic for Sunday, September 17, 2017. Hamburg's and hotdogs will be provided by the club and the picnic will be at Jerry and Roxanne Thornton's house, 323 Patison Ave. Marienville Pa. The club will be having their outdoor grill raffle, \$50.00 scarecrow lottery raffle as well as their PLINKO game. Club applications will be available at the booth.

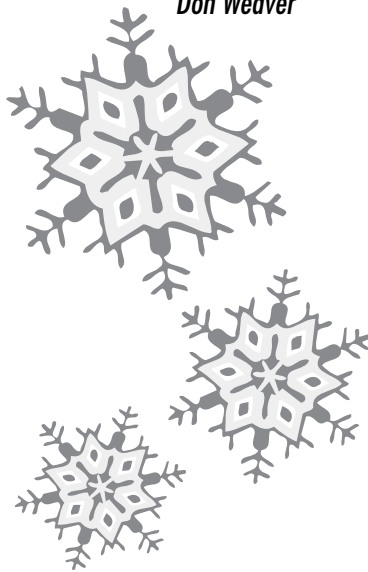

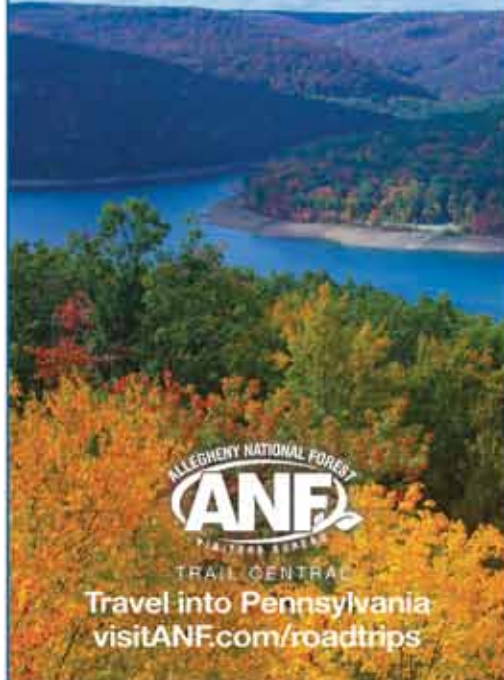

VINTAGE FLASHBACKS

The Keystone Snowmobiler would like to invite you to contribute to a special project we have recently started. This involves recording the history of folks and businesses that sold snowmobiles "back in the good old days". We're talking about the real heyday when snowmobiling as a sport was relatively new and there were hundreds of brands on the market. From the 1960's up to and including 1981 is the timeframe we are trying to primarily research for this history.

Today, there are four brand names in the snowmobile business. In the early-to-mid seventies, literally hundreds of brands disappeared. In 1981, the former Arctic Enterprises (Arctic Cat) went bankrupt and then re-appeared with a new company for the 1984 model year. Besides the four brands we have today, only 2 other manufacturers offered snowmobiles past '81: Kawasaki stayed through the 1982 model year, and John Deere quit at the end of the 1984 model year.

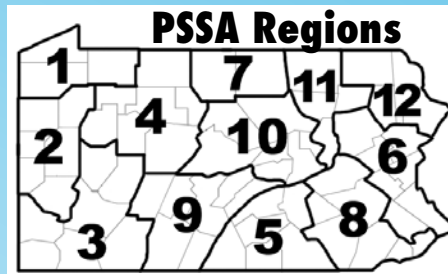
